**94** points

"Not an effusive aroma, with touches of citrus and the sea. On the palate, this is concentrated and seamless, with balance and harmony. Just needs time to show all its features. Offers fine length, with a chalky feel at the end."

2007 Puligny-Montrachet 1er Cru Les Pucelles

**93** points

"A rich, open-textured white, with lemon, lime, apple and spice notes. Turns more elegant on the finish, offering toast and spice on the aftertaste, with a perception of light tannins. There's grip as well, with a sense that this is holding back a little right now."

**93** points

"A rich white for the vintage, featuring peach, grapefruit, butter and vanilla notes. This has power, but also harmony, revealing a fine balance between its firm structure and fleshy texture. Terrific length."

"Shy in aroma, this lean, racy white has intensity. Lemon curd, apple, pastry and chalk notes mingle as this turns firm and bracing on the mouthwatering finish. Very refined."
