Appellation: Venezia Giulia I.G.T.

Grape varieties: Blend of two-thirds of Pinot Bianco and Pinot Grigio, with small percentages of Ribolla Gialla and Sauvignon that give harmony and freshness

Vineyard location: In the hillsides in the vicinity of the winery with exposure prevalence to the south

Soil composition: Marl

Density/training: 4,500-5,000 vines/hectare (1,820-2,025 vines/acre); arched cane and Guyot trained

Viticulture: Sustainable

Harvest: Grape varieties are harvested separately when fully ripened

Winemaking: Soft press of whole grapes followed by racking and fermentation in temperature-controlled stainless-steel vats. The wines are blended after fermentation and aged on the lees for at least 7 months. At 11 months after harvest, the wine is bottled.

Alcohol: 13%

Total acidity: 5.2g/L

Tasting notes: Straw yellow color; elegant and refined on the nose with hints of Golden Delicious apple and ripe fruit; velvety sensations on the palate.

Food pairings: Appetizers, soups and broths, egg and fish dishes

Production: 16,000 750ml bottles



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
