PEYRASSOL

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Commanderie de Peyrassol is located in the foothills of the Massif des Maures mountain range, 10 miles from the Mediterranean Sea, between Cannes and Marseille. Existing as a winery for almost 800 years, Commanderie de Peyrassol today consists of 1,000 hectares with 95 hectares planted to vineyards cultivated on dry, rocky clay and limestone soils.

CHÂTEAU GASSIER

With roots in Provence that date back to 1421, the Gassier family established their winery in 1982. Located in Sainte-Victoire at the heart of Provence, Château Gassier produces classic Provençal rosés with elegant style.

MAS LA CHEVALIÈRE

Mas la Chevalière is considered a reference point in the Languedoc region for both its selection of cool climate terroirs and the quality of its winery equipment, which allows for the precise expression of each grape variety and vineyard parcel.

CHÊNE BLEU

Located 2,000 feet high in altitude, where the boundaries of Gigondas, Séguret and the Ventoux come together, these 50-year-old vineyards benefit from the warmth of the southern Rhône and the cool climate of the high elevation. Planted on complex mineral and limestone soil, the vines — in conjunction with the historical techniques and modern technology — offer balanced grapes, delicately vinified.

DOMAINE DE BEAURENARD

Representing the 8th generation and based in the heart of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Victor and his brother, Antonin Coulon, are following their family's philosophy with a certified biodynamic rosé coming from the southern Rhône valley area.

FEUDO MONTONI

Located in the heart of Sicily, Feudo Montoni has been producing top-quality wines on its historic grounds since 1469. The vines have always been cultivated using the Sireci family's traditional organic methods and the winery produces many of Italy's most celebrated 100% indigenous varietals.



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
